Level 1 Safeguarding Children at Risk</p> <p>This Level 1 Safeguarding Children course provides delegates with the knowledge and skills needed to safeguard children. It describes the common types of abuse, how to recognise them, and how to respond to your concerns. It also explains how to correctly report your concerns.</p> <p>By the end of the course delegates will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Demonstrate knowledge of the signs and symptoms of different types of child abuse. ▪ Demonstrate understanding of how, and why, we work with other agencies to safeguard children. ▪ Explain what to do if you have safeguarding concerns about a child, a colleague, or practices within an organisation. ▪ Explore barriers to disclosure of abuse. ▪ Examined values and attitudes in relation to adult abuse. ▪ Demonstrate an understanding of child protection processes. ▪ A basic understanding of the law and local Safeguarding procedures and principles.
